

DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES – SCHEDULE 230

The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and (Free Parking Places)
(Amendment No. F23) Order 20-

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. F24) Order 20-

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council proposes to make the above Traffic Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.

1. The general effect of the Orders would be to:

- a) Revoke the disabled parking places in the vicinity of No. 62 Beauchamp Road, Upper Norwood, No. 13 Ecclesbourne Road, Thornton Heath, No. 10 Goston Gardens, Thornton Heath, No. 173 Green Lane, Norbury, No. 7 Hurlstone Road, South Norwood, No. 88 Isham Road, Norbury, No. 11 Kenmore Road, Kenley, No. 13 Marlborough Road, South Croydon, No. 36 Peshurst Road, Thornton Heath, No. 34 Sandown Road, South Norwood, No. 8 Wontford Road, Purley and No. 9 Wrights Road, South Norwood.
- b) Designate new parking places at which vehicles displaying a disabled persons' badge may be left without charge or time limit in the following locations.

Addiscombe Avenue, Croydon	Adjacent to the flank wall of No. 67 Dalmally Road
Alton Road, Croydon	Outside No. 48 and partially across the frontage of No. 46
Beauchamp Road, Upper Norwood	Outside No. 86 and partially across the frontage of No. 84
Bourne Street, Croydon	Outside No. 30 and partially across the frontage of No. 29 (replaces one permit/payment parking bay)
Braemar Avenue, South Croydon	Outside No. 94
Chasemore Gardens, Croydon	In the inset parking area at the rear of No. 12 (bay at 90 degrees to the kerb, relocation of the existing disabled bay outside No. 7)
Clifton Road, Coulsdon	Outside No. 36
Fairholme Road, Croydon	Outside No. 92 and partially across the frontage of No. 90 (replaces one permit/payment parking bay)
Foulsham Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 29 and partially across the frontage of No. 31
Godson Road, Croydon	Outside No. 10
Grace Road, Croydon	Adjacent to the rear of No. 23 Tirrell Road (replaces one permit/payment parking bay)
Grange Park Road, Thornton Heath	Partially outside Nos. 36 and 38 (replaces one permit/payment parking bay)
Lomond Gardens, South Croydon	Outside No. 33 and partially across the frontage of No. 32
Lyndhurst Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 43 and partially across the frontage of No. 45
Mead Place, Croydon	Outside No. 9 (replaces one permit/payment parking bay)
Mersham Road, Thornton Heath	Outside Nos. 217/219
Pollards Hill South, Norbury	Partially outside Nos. 51 and 53
Richmond Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 78 and partially across the frontage of No. 76
Sandringham Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 22 (replaces one permit/payment parking bay)
Sharland Close, Thornton Heath	In the inset area adjacent to the flank wall of No. 31 (replaces a length of double yellow lines)
Silverleigh Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 108

- c) Amend the map-based tiles to the Schedule attached to the above Orders so as to accurately represent the new parking arrangements as they exist on site.
2. A copy of the proposed Orders and all related documents can be inspected between 9am and 4pm, Monday to Friday inclusive, until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, by appointment with the Parking Design Team, at Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA (telephone 020 8726 6000 and ask for Parking Design).
