CROYDON**

The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and
(Free Parking Places) (No.13) Order 2023

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (No.13) Order 2023

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on 19 June 2023 made the above Traffic Orders under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Orders will be:**
 - a) **To introduce “at any time” double yellow line waiting restrictions in the lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice.**
 - b) **To update the map-based tiles to the Schedule attached to the above Orders to accurately represent the new arrangements as they exist on site.**
3. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 26 June 2023, and of all associated Orders can be inspected by appointment with the Parking Design Team from 9am to 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, at the “Access Croydon” Facility, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA (telephone 020 8726 6000 and ask for Parking Design).

5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE
(Introducing double yellow line waiting restrictions “at any time”)

Arundel Avenue, South Croydon

- The north-west side, from its junction with Upper Selsdon Road for 13 metres south-westwards.
- The south-east side, from its junction with Upper Selsdon Road for 10 metres south-westwards.

Braemar Avenue, Thornton Heath

Both sides, from its junction with Bridport Road for 7 metres north-eastwards.

Bridport Road, Thornton Heath

The south-west side:

- for 7 metres either side of its junction with Stratford Road
- for 7 metres either side of its junction with Totton Road
- for 7 metres either side of its junction with Warwick Road
- from its junction with Winterbourne Road for 7 metres north-westwards

The north-east side:

- for 7 metres either side of its junction with Braemar Avenue
- from its junction with Winterbourne Road for 7 metres north-westwards

Dunley Drive, Croydon

The north-west side, from its junction with Fieldway for 10 metres north-eastwards.

Ellesmere Drive, South Croydon

Both sides, from its junction with Wentworth Way for 10 metres south-eastwards.

Fairhaven Avenue, Croydon

Both sides, from its junction with Gladeside for 10 metres south-westwards.

Fieldway, Croydon

- The north-east side, from its junction with Dunley Drive for 10 metres north-westwards.
- The south-west side, from its junction with Dunley Drive for 15 metres south-westwards.

Foxley Road, Thornton Heath

Both sides, from its junction with Richmond Road for 7 metres south-westwards.

Gladeside, Croydon

The south-west side, for 10 metres either side of its junction with Fairhaven Avenue.

Grove Road, Thornton Heath

The north-west side, between the north-western boundary of Silchester Court, London Road, and the south-western boundary of Lidl, No. 845 London Road.

Harold Road, Upper Norwood

The north-west side, for 10 metres either side of its junction with Orleans Road.

Kerrill Avenue, Coulsdon

Both sides, from its junction with The Glade for 10 metres eastwards.

Linden Avenue, Thornton Heath

Both sides, from its junction with Richmond Road for 7 metres south-westwards.

Orleans Road, Upper Norwood

- The north-east side, from its junction with Harold Road for 12.5 metres north-westwards.
- The south-west side, from its junction with Harold Road for 10 metres north-westwards.

Richmond Road, Thornton Heath

The south-west side:

- from its junction with Winterbourne Road for 7 metres south-eastwards
- either side of its junction with Stratford Road for 7 metres
- either side of its junction with Linden Avenue for 7 metres
- either side of its junction with Foxley Road for 7 metres
- either side of its junction with Warlingham Road for 7 metres

The north-east side:

- from its junction with Winterbourne Road for 7 metres south-eastwards

Russell Hill, Purley

The east side, from a point 5 metres north of its junction with The Close for 16.5 metres southwards.

Stratford Road, Thornton Heath

From its junction with Richmond Road for 7 metres south-westwards

The Glade, Coulsdon

The north-west side, for 10 metres either side of its junction with Kerrill Avenue.

Totton Road, Thornton Heath

Both sides, from its junction with Bridport Road for 7 metres south-westwards.

Upper Selsdon Road, South Croydon

The south-west side, from a point 13.5 metres south-east of its junction with Arundel Avenue to a point 10 metres north-west of that junction.

Warlingham Road, Thornton Heath

Both sides, from its junction with Richmond Road for 7 metres south-westwards.

Warwick Road, Thornton Heath

- The north-west side, from its junction with Bridport Road for 8 metres south-westwards.
- The south-east side, from its junction with Bridport Road for 7 metres south-westwards.

Wentworth Way, South Croydon

The south-east side, either side its junction with Ellesmere Drive for 10 metres.

Winterbourne Road, Thornton Heath

Both sides, either side of its junction with Richmond Road/Bridport Road for 7 metres.
