ST. JAMES'S ROAD, CROYDON
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate works to install new electrical service connections they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic in St. James's Road.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place St. James's Road will be closed eastbound between the railway bridge and its junction with Newgate.
3. Whilst the closure is in place the diversion route for traffic will be via Newgate/A222, Wellesley Road/A212, Park Lane, Barclay Road/A232, Fairfield Road/A232, Chepstow Road/A232, Addiscombe Road/A232 and Shirley Road/A215, as appropriately signed.
4. The Order will come into operation on 03 August 2023, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 17 August 2023. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
