TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER

FILMING ON THE HIGHWAY IN SMITH'S YARD, CROYDON
CLOSURE OF PARK LANE SLIP ROAD
ASSOCIATED RESTRICTIONS

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate filming in Smith's Yard, Croydon, they intend to make a Traffic Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict traffic movements in Park Lane slip road (fronting the former St George's House, Park Lane, Croydon).
2. During the filming, Park Lane slip road will be closed between its junction with Katharine Street and the gated entrance to Smith's Yard.
3. The provisions of the Order will not prevent access being maintained for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which the Order relates, or to any other premises accessible from, and only from, such a road.
4. The Order will come into effect on 19 July 2023, and it is anticipated that the road will be closed from 07.00 hours on that date until and 17.00 hours on 20 July 2023, although the prohibition will remain in force for the whole day on both days.

6. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) A vehicle being used in connection with the filming
 - (b) A vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) Anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
