

DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES – SCHEDULE 232

The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and (Free Parking Places)
(Amendment No. F33) Order 20-

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. F34) Order 20-

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council proposes to make the above Traffic Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.

1. The general effect of the Orders would be to:

- a) Revoke the disabled parking places in the vicinity of No. 4 Broad Green Avenue, Croydon, No. 354 Brigstock Road, Thornton Heath, No. 37 Clarence Road, Croydon, No. 22 Helder Street, South Croydon, No. 114 Homestead Way, New Addington, No. 59 Lebanon Road, Croydon, No. 7/9 Little Roke Avenue, Kenley, No. 175 Oak Avenue, Croydon, No. 36 Selhurst Place, South Norwood, Sunderland Court, No. 2 Norbury Avenue, Thornton Heath, No. 1 Warwick Road, Thornton Heath, No. 98 Windsor Road, Thornton Heath, and No. 3 Wyvern Road, Purley.
- b) Designate new parking places at which vehicles displaying a disabled persons' badge may be left without charge or time limit in the following locations.

Barmouth Road, Croydon	Outside No. 71 and partially across the frontage of No. 69
Beauchamp Road, Upper Norwood	Outside No. 15 (partial footway bay - two wheels up)
Beauchamp Road, Upper Norwood	Partially across the frontages of No. 118 and 120
Belmont Road, South Norwood	Outside No. 45 and partially across the frontage of No. 43
Bredon Road, Croydon	Outside No. 53 and partially across the frontage of No. 51
Cheston Avenue, Croydon	Outside Nos. 115 / 117
Crowland Road, Thornton Heath	Outside Thornton Heath Health Centre (formalising an existing advisory bay)
Essex Grove, Upper Norwood	Outside No. 5
Grove Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 70
Howberry Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 61 and partially across the frontage of No. 59
Kingfisher Gardens, South Croydon	Outside No. 32
Leander Road, Thornton Heath	Outside No. 58
Nova Road, Croydon	Outside No. 18 and partially across the frontages of Nos. 16 & 20 (replaces one space in a permit/payment bay)
Orchard Rise, Croydon	Partially outside Nos. 46 and 48
Sandown Road, South Norwood	Outside No. 79 and partially across the frontage of No. 81
Sheldon Street, Croydon	Outside No. 21 (replaces a section of single yellow line)
Southbrook Road, Norbury	Outside No. 8
Stroud Green Way, Croydon	Outside No. 77
The Lawns, Upper Norwood	Outside No. 39 (partial footway bay - two wheels up)
The Retreat, Thornton Heath	Adjacent to the flank wall of No. 46 High Street, Thornton Heath (formalising an existing advisory bay)
Woodcroft Road, Thornton Heath	Adjacent to the flank wall of No. 33 Mayday Road (replaces a section of double yellow lines)

- c) Amend the map-based tiles to the Schedule attached to the above Orders to accurately represent the new parking arrangements as they exist on site.
2. A copy of the proposed Orders and all related documents can be inspected between 9am and 4pm, Monday to Friday inclusive, until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, by appointment with the Parking Design Team, at Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA (telephone 020 8726 6000 and ask for Parking Design).
