ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

BROUGHTON ROAD, THORNTON HEATH
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate new water connection works on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic movements in Broughton Road, Thornton Heath.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place, Broughton Road will be closed between the north-eastern boundary of No. 73 Broughton Road and the south-western boundary of No. 71b Broughton Road.
3. During the closure road plates will be provided to maintain residents' access.
4. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
5. The Order will come into operation on 25 August 2023, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed in five days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The restriction will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
