CROHAM ROAD, SOUTH CROYDON  
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a detailed examination of the railway bridge, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict vehicular and pedestrian traffic in Croham Road.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:-
  - (a) the northern footway of Croham Road will be closed under the railway bridge.
  - (b) the carriageway of Croham Road will be closed between its junction with Mugeridge Close and the western boundary of Nos. 30a and 30c Croham Road.
3. Whilst the footway closure is in place pedestrians will be directed to the opposite footway. The alternative route for vehicular traffic during the closure will be via St Peter's Road (B274), Coombe Road (A212), South Park Hill Road, Croham Road and vice versa.
4. The Order will come into operation on 28 November 2023, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed overnight between 10pm and 6am. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) any vehicle or person involved in carrying out the said works.
  - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
