ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED,
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL
OTHER ENABLING POWERS

DEEPDENE AVENUE AND RANMORE AVENUE, CROYDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate telecoms works on behalf of BT, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic and parking in Deepdene Avenue and Ranmore Avenue, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) The carriageway and western (even-numbered side) footway of Deepdene Avenue will be closed from a point 100 metres south of its junction with Selborne Road to the southern end of the road.
 - b) The carriageway and southern (even-numbered side) footway of Ranmore Avenue will be closed between its junction with Deepdene Avenue and a point 85 metres west of its junction with Radcliffe Road.
 - c) Parking bays on both sides of Deepdene Avenue (between the common boundary of No. 7 Deepdene Avenue and No.1 Ranmore Avenue and the southern end of the road) will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply within those areas at any time.
3. The Order will come into operation on 12 February 2024, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed within one day. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
4. During the closure the alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Park Hill Rise, Selborne Road, B243, Chepstow Road and Radcliffe Road, as appropriately signposted. Pedestrians will be directed to the opposite footway.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
