SHIRLEY WAY, CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate water service pipe works by Thames Water, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Shirley Way.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) The carriageway of Shirley Way will be closed between its junctions with Bridle Road and Tideswell Road.
 - b) The southern (even-numbered side) footway of Shirley Way will be closed between its junctions with Bridle Road and Tideswell Road.
3. During the works the diversion routes for vehicular traffic will be via Bridle Road, Devonshire Way, Langland Gardens, Bennetts Way, The Lees, Shirley Way and reversed, or via Bridle Road, Lime Tree Grove, Tideswell Road, Shirley Way and reversed, as appropriately signed. Pedestrians affected by the footway closure will be directed to the opposite footway.
4. The Order will come into operation on 02 April 2024 and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 08 April 2024. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
