THE AVENUE, COULSDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate gas main remediation works by SGN, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit traffic movements in The Avenue, Coulsdon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place The Avenue will be closed at its junction with Brighton Road.
3. During the closure the diversion routes for vehicular traffic will be via The Grove, The Drive, Brighton Road and vice versa, or via Brighton Road Malcolm Road and Woodcote Grove Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on 01 April 2024, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 16 May 2024. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
