

**CROYDON COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14, AS AMENDED
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC– ALBERT ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD**

1. Croydon Council, **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate crane operations to complete building development works they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic movements in Albert Road.
2. Whilst the works are taking place Albert Road will be closed between its junction with Eldon Park and the north-western boundary of No. 105 Albert Road.
3. During the closure the diversion route for traffic will be via Harrington Road, Cresswell Road and Addison Road or via Albert Road, Coventry Road, Portland Road and Harrington Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on the 11 April 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within twelve months. However, the Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The provisions of the Order will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
6. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
