FITZROY GARDENS UPPER NORWOOD

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate cabling works on behalf of UKPN, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic movements in Fitzroy Gardens, Upper Norwood.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Fitzroy Gardens will be closed to vehicular traffic from a point 30 metres north-west of its junction with Church Road to the common boundary of Nos. 4 and 6 Fitzroy Gardens.
 - b) The north-eastern (even-numbered side) footway of Fitzroy Gardens will be closed to pedestrians from a point 30 metres north-west of its junction with Church Road to the common boundary of Nos. 4 and 6 Fitzroy Gardens.
3. During the closure residents' access will be maintained. Pedestrians affected by the footway closure will be diverted into a walkway in the carriageway.
4. The Order will come into operation on 10 June 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out within five days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
