As the premises licence holder we will make sure that the staff who are on duty are trained and experienced. They will be advised and would be given all instructions and details to meet and fulfill the licensing objectives such as the prevention of crime and disorder. There will be enough staff to control and manage any issues or problems that may arise as they will have the knowledge on how to deal with the problem.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder *

Crimes can be prevented as there are CCTV systems in place being monitored and maintained at the property regularly. Any type of criminal incidents that may take place on the premises will be reported to the Police. There are cameras fixed in most corners so that it can record anyone entering and leaving the shop which can be very useful as crimes are less likely to occur as there are camera systems around the premises.

c) Public safety *

There are fire safety systems in place such as fire extinguishers and fire signs/exits etc. These are all serviced and we have yearly maintenances to ensure everything is in perfect condition. Employees will all be trained and instructed clearly about these to ensure everyone is safe.

Licensing Objectives

d) The prevention of public nuisance *

Notices will be displayed on premises to remind customers to leave quietly considering the local community and other businesses. Staff who are on duty will also encourage customers to leave quietly without making lots of noise and trouble. When possible the front door will be shut mostly which will help noise being reduced.

e) The protection of children from harm *

Make sure that children are not by themselves and make sure they are accompanied by someone. There are no alcohol being sold here as we would just be selling hot food.
