ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED, THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

DINGWALL ROAD, CROYDON TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate a crane operation, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict traffic in Dingwall Road, Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:-
- a) The carriageway of Dingwall Road will be closed between its junctions with the eastern and western arms of Lansdowne Road and the southern boundary of Ruskin Square car park, Dingwall Road.
- b) The eastern footway of Dingwall Road will be closed outside the Ruskin Square car park.
- c) The cycle lane on the western side of Dingwall Road will be closed between the roundabout at the junction with Lansdowne Road and a point opposite the southern boundary of Ruskin Square car park.
- 3. Whilst the Order remains in force, residents' access to Lansdowne Road up to its junction with Walpole Road will be maintained. Pedestrians affected by the footway closure will be directed to the opposite footway and diverted onto private land. Cyclists using the cycle lane will be asked to dismount and use the footway.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 08 June 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 09 June 2024 (back-up dates of 15 and 16 June may apply if the work is delayed). The Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
