ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

HOOK HILL, SOUTH CROYDON TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate telegraph pole renewal works, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Hook Hill.
- 2. During the works Hook Hill will be closed between its junction with Arkwright Road and the north to south arm of Hook Hill (which runs between No. 25 Briton Hill Road and the island site at the junction).
- 3. Whilst the closure is in place the alternative routes for traffic will be via Hook Hill, Briton Hill Road and reversed, as appropriately signposted.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 02 July 2024, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
