ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED

THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

AUCKLAND ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the installation of a new raised zebra crossing, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Auckland Road.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Auckland Road will be closed outside No. 70 Auckland Road.
3. During the closure the alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Anerley Hill, Westow Hill, Church Road, South Norwood Hill, High Street, Lancaster Road, and reversed, as appropriately signposted.
4. The Order will come into operation on 29 July 2024, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 16 August 2024. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibition will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
