PN112 - CROYDON COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

SUMNER ROAD SOUTH, CROYDON TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate cabling works on behalf of UKPN, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic movements in Sumner Road South.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
- a) Sumner Road South will be closed between its junction with Onslow Road and the common boundary of Nos. 161 and 163 Sumner Road South.
- b) The south-eastern footway of Sumner Road South will be closed outside No. 159 Sumner Road South.
- During the closure, the alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Onslow Road, Kingsley Road, Chapman Road, Euston Road, Sumner Road South and vice versa. Pedestrians will be diverted to the opposite footway.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 22 July 2024, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 26 July 2024. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any person or vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
