GREENSIDE ROAD, CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate new gas connection works by SGN, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic movements in Greenside Road, Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Greenside Road will be closed outside No. 43 Greenside Road.
 - b) One-way working in Greenside Road will be suspended to allow two-way traffic.
- 3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative route for diverted traffic will be via London Road, Midhurst Avenue and Sutherland Road, as appropriately signed.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 23 September 2024, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out in seven days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.
- 5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
