INTRODUCTION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING BAYS AND CHARGING POINTS – VARIOUS LOCATIONS WITHIN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON

The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and (Free Parking Places) (No. 27) Order 2024

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (No. 27) Order 2024

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on 23 September 2024 made the above Traffic Orders under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and all other enabling powers to install electric vehicle charging bays and points.
2. **The general effect of the Orders will be:**
 - (a) To provide parking places which may be used free of charge by electrically propelled vehicles that are being charged with electrical power, operational at any time on Mondays to Sundays inclusive, in the locations detailed in the Schedule to this Notice.
 - (b) To install electric vehicle charging points adjacent to the proposed parking places, as specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
 - (c) To amend the map-based tiles to the Schedule attached to the above Orders to accurately represent the new parking arrangements as they exist on site.
NOTE: although parking in the electric vehicle bays is free of charge there is normally a cost involved in the use of the adjacent electric vehicle charging points.
3. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 30 September 2024 and of all associated Orders can be inspected between 9am and 4pm, Monday to Friday inclusive, until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made by appointment with the Parking Design Team, at Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA (telephone 020 8726 6000 and ask for Parking Design). Alternatively all related documents or further information can be requested by email to Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk.
4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE - ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING BAYS

Street Name	Location of Electric Vehicle Charging Bays	Location of Charging Points
Constance Road, Croydon	The south side, one 5.2 metre bay adjacent to the flank wall of No. 40 Bensham Lane (replaces one permit/payment bay)	The south side, located 16 metres east of the junction with Bensham Lane
Graham Road, Purley	The north-west side, one 6 metre bay adjacent to the rear of No. 5. Beaumont Road.	The north-west side located 12 metres north-east of the common boundary of No. 5 Beaumont Road and No. 2 Graham Road.
Haydn Avenue, Kenley	The north-east side, one 6 metre bay outside No. 23.	The north-east side, located 5.5 metres north-west of the common boundary of Nos. 23 and 25 Haydn Avenue.
Lodge Hill, Purley	The south side, one 6 metre bay 11.5 metres west of the junction with Haydn Avenue, adjacent to the flank wall of No. 56 Haydn Avenue.	The south side, located 16.5 metres west of the junction with Haydn Avenue.
Kenley Lane, Kenley	The north-east side, one 6 metre bay outside Kenley Station, 10.5 metres north-west of the south-eastern end of the free parking bay (replaces one free parking space).	The north-east side, located 11 metres north-west of the south-eastern end of the free parking bay outside Kenley Station.
Oaks Road, Kenley	The south-west side, one 6 metre bay adjacent to the flank wall of No. 1 Kenmore Road.	The south-west side, located 10 metres south-east of the junction with Kenmore Road.
Tedder Road, South Croydon	The south-west side, one 6 metre bay outside No. 109.	The south-west side, located adjacent to the common boundary of Nos. 109 and 111.
Valley Road, Kenley	The north-east side, one 6 metre bay outside No. 48.	The north-east side, located 5 metres south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 46 and 48.
