CHERRY HILL GARDENS, GODSON ROAD, RIGBY CLOSE &
THE RIDGEWAY, CROYDON
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate water main replacement works, they intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic and parking in the roads listed in the Schedule to this Notice.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) The roads listed in the Schedule to this notice will be subject to phased closures during the dates shown.
 - b) Parking will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time in the roads listed in the Schedule to this notice during the dates shown.
3. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. Whilst closures are in force, the alternative routes for traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Godson Road Closure: Via Courtney Road, Waddon Road, Purley Way and reversed.
 - The Ridgeway Closure: Court Drive, and The Ridgeway.
5. The Order will come into operation on 14 October 2024, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out as shown in the Schedule to this notice. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
6. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
