ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

BORROWDALE DRIVE & GLEBE HYRST, SOUTH CROYDON TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement works they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Borrowdale Drive and Glebe Hyrst.
- Whilst the said works are taking place:-
- a) Borrowdale Drive will be closed at its junction with Rectory Park.
- b) Glebe Hyrst will be closed at its junction with Rectory Park.
- 3. Whilst the closures are in force, the diversion routes for vehicular traffic will be as detailed below.
- Borrowdale Drive Access will be maintained but restricted.
- Glebe Hyrst closure Via Glebe Way, and B269 Rectory Park, or via Shaw Crescent, Court Hill, Westfield Avenue and Rectory Park.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 14 November 2024, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed within approximately three weeks. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 6. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) a vehicle involved in the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
