ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED,
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL
OTHER ENABLING POWERS
COMPTON ROAD, SEFTON ROAD & SELWOOD ROAD CROYDON
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement works by SGN, they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict traffic in Compton Road, Sefton Road and Selwood Road, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place the full lengths of Compton Road, Sefton Road and Selwood Road will be closed
3. During the closures the diversion routes for vehicular traffic will be as detailed below. Access to properties will be maintained.
 - Compton Road, Westbound: via Bingham Road, Sefton Road, Selwood Road.
 - Compton Road, Eastbound: via Bingham Road, Shirley Road, Ashburton Avenue, Craigen Avenue, Selwood Road .
 - Sefton Road, Westbound: via Bingham Road, Northampton Road, Carlyle Road, Fryston Road.
 - Sefton Road, Eastbound: via Bingham Road, Compton Road, Selwood Road.
 - Selwood Road, Northbound: via Compton Road, Ashburton Road, Craigen Avenue.
 - Selwood Road, Southbound: via Birch Tree Way, A232, Addiscombe Road , Green Court Gardens, Green Court Avenue, Craigen Avenue.
 - Selwood Road, Eastbound: via Compton Road, Bingham Road, Fryston Avenue, Carlyle Road, Northampton Road, Addiscombe Road, Birch Tree Way.
4. The Order will come into operation on 28 November 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed by the end of January 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
