CLIFFORD ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD

TEMPORARY CLOSURE

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate new water connection works, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic in Clifford Road, South Norwood.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place Clifford Road will be closed between its junctions with Carmichael Road and Portland Road.
- 3. During the closure traffic will be diverted via Stanger Road, Crowther Road, and Portland Road, or via Carmichael Road, Sidney Road, Merton Road, Birchanger Road, Elborough Road, Holland Road and Portland Road, as appropriately signed.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 02 December 2024, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed within four days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
