ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED, THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

DINGWALL ROAD & LANSDOWNE ROAD, CROYDON TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate water service disconnection works on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict traffic in Dingwall Road and Lansdowne Road, Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
- a) The cycle lane in Dingwall Road will be closed between the south-eastern boundary of Carolyn House, Nos. 22 - 26 Dingwall Road, and its junction with Lansdowne Road.
- b) The cycle lane in Lansdowne Road will be closed between its junctions with Dingwall Road and Walpole Road.
- 3. Whilst the closures are in force, cyclists will be advised to dismount and use a temporary walkway in the carriageway.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 03 December 2024, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 06 December 2024. However, the Order will remain in force for a maximum duration of 18 months to be reintroduced if further work is required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in conducting the said work.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
