MARLPIT LANE, COULSDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate a detailed examination of two railway bridges, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic movements in Marlpit Lane, Coulsdon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place, no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in Marlpit Lane between its junctions with Ullswater Crescent and the A23 Farthing Way slip road.
- 3. During the closure the alternative route for traffic will be via the A23, A22, Burntwood Lane, Banstead Road, B2030 and B276, as appropriately signed.
- 4. The Order will come into operation at 10pm on 05 December 2024 and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out overnight and completed by 6am on 06 December 2024. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.
- 5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
