ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

ADDISCOMBE GROVE, CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate kerb and footway works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic movements in Addiscombe Grove.
- 2. Whilst the works are taking place:
 - a) Addiscombe Grove will be closed southbound between its junctions with Addiscombe Road and Hazledean Road.
 - b) The eastern footway of Addiscombe Grove, including the cycle lane, will be closed between its junction with Addiscombe Road and the northern boundary of the East Croydon United Reformed Church, Addiscombe Grove.
- 3. The Order will come into operation on 06 January 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 25 January 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 4. Whilst the closure is in place the alternative routes for motorised vehicular traffic will be via Cherry Orchard Road, Lower Addiscombe Road, Shirley Road, Addiscombe Road, Chepstow Road, and Fairfield Road. The alternative route for cycles will be via Addiscombe Road, Altyre Road and Hazledean Road. Pedestrians will be diverted to the opposite footway.
- 5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
