FOXEARH ROAD, SOUTH CROYDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to enable fault rectification works on behalf of Openreach, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic in Foxearth Road, South Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place Foxearth Road will be closed between its junction with Addington Road and a point fifteen metres northwest of that junction.
3. During the closure, the alternative route for vehicles will be via Foxearth Road, Farley Road, A2022, Addington Road, and vice versa
4. The Order will come into operation on the 08 January 2025, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 09 January 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. The prohibition will only apply during such times and to such extents as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
6. The prohibition will not apply to any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work, to any vehicle used for police, ambulance, or fire brigade purposes, or to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
