The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and  
(Free Parking Places) (No.2) Order 2025

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (No.2) Order 2025

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on 30 December 2024 made the above Traffic Orders under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Orders will be:**
  - a) **To introduce “at any time” double yellow line waiting restrictions in the lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice.**
  - b) **To update the map-based tiles to the Schedule attached to the above Orders to accurately represent the new arrangements as they exist on site.**
3. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 06 January 2025, and of all associated Orders can be inspected from 9am to 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, at the “Access Croydon” Facility, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

**SCHEDULE**

**(Introducing double yellow line waiting restrictions “at any time”)**

**Firs Road, Kenley**

The south-west side, for 10 metres either side of its junction with Wattendon Road.

**Parchmore Road, Thornton Heath**

The south-west side, from the common boundary of Nos. 187 and 189 Parchmore Road to the north-western end of the partial footway parking bay outside No. 185 Parchmore Road.

**Wattendon Road, Kenley**

- Both sides, from its junction with Firs Road south-westward for 15 metres.
- Both sides, from the common boundary of Nos. 35 and 37 Wattendon Road to a point 4 metres south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 20 and 22 Wattendon Road.
- Both sides, from the common boundary of Nos. 19 and 21 Wattendon Road to a point 3.6 metres west of the common boundary of Nos. 9 and 11 Wattendon Road.
