PROGRESS WAY, CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate high voltage cable works by UK Power Solutions, they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic in Progress Way.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place Progress Way will be closed between its junction with Beddington Farm Road and the goods entrance to Furniture Village, at No. 222 Purley Way.
- 3. During the closure, the diversion routes for traffic will be via Commerce Way, Purley Way, and Beddington Farm Road, or via Beddington Farm Road, Ampere Way, Faraday Way, Purley Way, and Commerce Way.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 23 January 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 05 February 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
- (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
- (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
- (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
