Parent Carer Panel

Two parent carer panel sessions have been held since our last newsletter.

On 20 June we held public speaking training for the parent carer panel. It was aimed at parents and carers who wanted to feel more confident when presenting or speaking to an audience.

The training was delivered by Alison Johnson who specialises in Parenting, Behaviour management, emotional wellbeing and resilience building for young people & adults.



On 18 July we held a parent carer panel meeting and invited the Croydon Early Learning Team to come and talk to the parents and carers about getting ready to start school.

They spoke about childcare funding and the changes to funding from September 2024.

Some working parents may be eligible for funded (free) childcare. You can apply for:

• 15 hours per week for children aged 9 months to 4 years

• 30 hours per week for children aged 3 and 4 years old

Apply and receive your code by 31 December to be eligible from 1 January. You can apply early and talk to your childcare provider about their arrangements.



If you have a two year old who is not eligible for the working parent funding and you are in receipt for certain benefits, you may be eligible for funding - for further information please see <u>Family Space</u> <u>Croydon.</u>

Healthy Start, Brighter Future

At HENRY, they are passionate about giving babies and children the best start in life by supporting families to make positive lifestyle changes and create healthier, happier homes.

Since February 2023, HENRY in Croydon has delivered over 30 free 8 week Healthy Families programmes and Starting Solids workshops, reaching more than 150 parents and carers.

Their Healthy Families, Brighter Future programme is for parents and carers with children under 7 in Croydon, offering face-to-face and online sessions on parenting strategies, nutrition, and balancing family life. Participants receive a full toolkit and a certificate upon completion.



HENRY also offer Starting Solids workshops for parents of babies under 6 months and Eat Well for Less workshops for families with children under 12, focusing on budget-friendly nutrition tips.

All programmes are led by their friendly team of healthy family facilitators. Parents with children under 7 can get in touch <u>here</u> for more information.

Additionally, the HENRY Core Training is a two-day course for Croydon practitioners, covering essential topics like health inequalities, early nutrition, emotional wellbeing, and parenting strategies to support families in fostering a healthy, happy childhood. 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About our Sessions...

Baby Fun for Under 1 (Non walkers) Make memories with age appropriate activities along with singing, instruments and nursery rhymes, Nappy painting and Hand & Foot prints.

Jumping Beans 0-4

A physical play session to encourage movement, balance and coordination. This type of play builds gross and fine motor skills and supports development of fitness skills and enjoyment of physical activity.

Rocking Rhymes

0-5 years. A music focussed session supports memory, learning sounds and meanings of words. Dancing to music helps children build motor skills while allowing them to practice self-expression.

Watch Me Grow

Messy and sensory activities for babies under 1 year old. Supporting children to understand how their actions affect what's around them, brain development, memory, complex tasks and problem solving. Includes access to sensory room.

Messy Play

A session for children aged 0-4 years. Children develop curiosity, initiative, focus and persistence through messy play. Simple activities, like playing with playdough or shredded paper, build fine and gross motor skills, supporting cause and effect, number sense, and other important cognitive skills.

Stay & Play

A play and learn session for children aged 0-5 years. This is a fun interactive session where children and parents can socialise and children can learn through play.

Forest School

A child-centred learning process, providing learner inspired, hands-on experiences in the natural environment. Encouraging children to explore the outdoors whilst stimulating curiosity and developing imaginative play.

Musical Bumps 6 months-2 years

Join us for musical fun and games, learn lots of new songs, play with puppets, dance and musical learning for babies and toddlers with their parents and carers.

Wriggles & Dribbles

Relax, Chat and Play. A supportive play session with breastfeeding peer support led by trained parents. For families with babies and children aged 0-2 years

Breastfeeding Buddies (Breastfeeding Support) A friendly and supportive breastfeeding group run by trained peer support volunteers.

You're Not Alone An informal support group for parents/ carers who have children with special needs. **Ball Pit** Soft play to promote balance, coordination and fine & gross motor skills. years. Family Support If you have something on your mind or would like some support then you can come along to talk to our family support worker or call to make an appointment.

Baby Massage (B) (Under 6 months) A 5-week course. A touching communication that enhances bonding & trust between parent and baby. Improving sense of wellbeing, increasing confidence in recognising baby's needs, Improved positive interaction with baby, Improved sleep for baby.

Baby Yoga (B) A style of yoga that encourages bonding between babies and their parents.
