SAXON ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD  
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF PARKING & PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate ferrule exchange works by Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict parking and pedestrian traffic in Saxon Road, South Norwood.
2. Whilst the said work is taking place:
  - a) Parking will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will be in place operating "at any time" on both sides of the road between the common boundaries of Nos. 8 and 12 and Nos. 18 and 20 Saxon Road.
  - b) The north-eastern footway of Saxon Road will be closed outside Nos. 12 to 18 and pedestrians will be diverted to the opposite footway.
3. The Order will come into operation on 20 January 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed within approximately four days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
4. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) any vehicle involved in conducting the said work.
  - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
