PN341 - CROYDON COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

BENSHAM LANE, DENNETT ROAD, HANDCROFT ROAD, CROYDON TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate ducting work by UK Power Solutions and works by other utilities in relation to a new housing development, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic and parking in Bensham Lane, Dennett Road and Handcroft Road, Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
- a) Bensham Lane will be closed between its junctions with Kelling Gardens and London Road.
- b) Dennett Road and Handcroft Road will be closed at their junctions with London Road.
- c) The three parking bays nearest to the junction with London Road, outside No. 1 Bensham Lane, will be suspended.
- 3. During the work the diversion routes for traffic will be as detailed below and appropriately signed.

Bensham Lane closure

- Via London Road, St James Road, Windmill Road and Queens Road.
- Via London Road, Campbell Road, Cameron Road and Queens Road.

Dennett Road Closure

• Via Sumner Road, Mitcham Road, and Dennett Road.

Handcroft Road closure

- Via Sumner Road and London Road.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 27 January 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 21 February 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
