London Borough of Croydon Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

Consultation document

Consultation period runs from 20 January 2025 to 16 February 2025

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1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Electoral Registration Act 2013 introduced a formal process for the timings of compulsory reviews of UK parliamentary polling districts and polling places. A full review of the whole borough must be undertaken at intervals of not less than 5 years. The last review was completed in January 2020.
- 1.2 Although the law requires a review of UK parliamentary polling districts and polling places, this is effectively a review for all elections that take place in Croydon as these will be used for local government elections.
- 1.3 The review cannot make any changes to the existing UK parliamentary constituency boundaries or the Croydon Council ward boundaries.
- 1.4 A polling district is a geographical area created by the sub-division of a parliamentary constituency for the purposes of a UK parliamentary election. To provide consistency the designated polling districts for UK parliamentary elections are also used at local government elections.
- 1.5 A polling place is the building or area in which the Returning Officer will locate a polling station. The polling place should be designated so that the polling station is within as easy reach as possible for all electors in the polling district.
- 1.6 A polling station is the room where voting takes place. For example, the polling place could be a school, and the polling station for the polling place is the School Hall.

2. Timetable for the Review

2.1 The timetable for the review is set out below:

3. Preliminary review and development of proposals for future arrangements

- 3.1 The Returning Officer has undertaken a preliminary review of the current polling arrangements in Croydon and developed proposals for the future. The following issues were considered:
 - The suitability of the polling place. A detailed assessment of all polling places took place in 2024. This included accessibility and facilities for the staff and electors.
 - The size of the polling district electorate. Following the introduction of Voter ID at polling stations, the Electoral Commission reduced the recommended maximum number of polling station electors from 2,500 to 2,250. Ideally polling station electorates will also be above 1,000.
 - How far electors have to travel to their polling place where possible, keeping this below 15 minutes' walk (the geography of the ward, the density of population, and availability of suitable venues means that this is not always possible).
 - The geography of the wards and routes that electors will take to travel to their polling place.
 - Whether any proposed changes to current arrangements are necessary or beneficial to electors, or if they would they cause more confusion or inconvenience for electors effected.
 - Proposed future residential developments over the next five years the changes this could have on the number of electors.
- 3.2 The Returning Officer's proposals for future arrangements are set out below in this document and on the Council's website (www.croydon.gov.uk/elections)

4. Public consultation process

- 4.1 A public consultation on the Returning Officer's proposals for future arrangements for polling districts and polling places will run from **Monday 20 January 2025** until midnight on **Sunday 16 February 2025**.
- 4.2 This consultation document will be published on the Council's website, and sent to the Croydon Members of Parliament, The Executive Mayor, Councillors, and local political parties. It will also be sent to individuals and organisations with particular expertise in relation to access to premises or who represent groups with protected status under the Equality Act 2010.
- 4.3 Any registered elector may make a representation.
- 4.4 Representations can be submitted by email or post to:

- 4.5 Anyone making representations are encouraged to suggest alternative polling districts/places where appropriate, and to give reasons for the alternative.
- 4.6 Following the close of the public consultation, all correspondence and representations received relating to the review must be published. For individual electors, this will include their name and the ward they are an elector in, but their address and contact information will not be published.

5. Completing the review

- 5.1 Following the public consultation, all representations will be considered, in addition to any further information regarding the availability or suitability of polling places. Council officers will then develop final recommendations for future arrangements.
- 5.2 The final recommendations will be published in a report to the Council's General Purposes Committee which is scheduled to meet on 29 April 2025.
- 5.3 Following ratification of the recommendations by the General Purposes Committee, any changes to polling districts will be made to the electoral register when it is updated on 1 May 2025.
- 5.4 New arrangements will take effect at any election where the Notice of Election is published on or after 1 May 2025.

Returning Officers' review of current arrangements and proposals for future polling districts and polling places

- 6.1 The current arrangements have been reviewed at a local government ward level, as these are the smallest electoral area boundaries that cannot be changed. A list of the proposed polling districts and polling places by Parliamentary Constituency are listed in Appendix's one to four.
- Only one ward, Woodside, is split between Parliamentary constituencies.


 Current polling district WDS1 is in Croydon West, and the rest of the ward is in Croydon East. The boundary between WDS1 and the other polling districts in the ward cannot change.

7. Addiscombe East

Current arrangements:


7.1 The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. The most significant issue with the current arrangements is the size of the electorate in ADE2 polling district which is significantly higher than the Electoral Commission's recommended maximum number (2,250). At the General Election in 2024 this was addressed by splitting the polling station register for the district and having two issuing desks at the polling station located at St Mildred's Church, increasing capacity.

Proposed future arrangements

- 7.2 It is proposed that in the future the division of ADE2 polling District is formalised, by splitting it into two separate polling districts, divided along the tram line. No venue for a polling place in the area west of the tram line has been identified, so the polling place for both districts would continue to be St Mildred's Church so there would be no negative impact on electors in this area
- 7.3 It would also make it easier administratively to have two polling districts and polling stations instead of splitting a polling station register between two issuing desks, for example for producing election documentation for the polling stations such as polling station registers and ballot paper accounts.
- 7.4 It is proposed that there are some amendments to the naming of the polling districts in the ward so they make more sense when looked at on a map. The west part of ADE2 will remain ADE2. The east part will be ADE3. What was ADE3 will be ADE5.



8. Addiscombe West

- 8.1 No change to the current arrangements are proposed. The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. The size of the electorates in the existing polling districts are below the Electoral Commission's recommended maximum number (2,250).
- 8.2 There are a significant number of new properties, around 600, located on Cherry Orchard Road which are either empty as they have only just been built, or they are still in development. This could increase the electorate in ADW3 polling district significantly.
- 8.3 It is proposed that this is monitored and if the electorate here does increase beyond the Electoral Commission's recommended amount, ADW3 could become a double polling station. This does not require a re-drawing of the polling district boundaries, instead splitting the polling station register between two issuing desks effectively doubling capacity. But that is a decision that can be taken in advance of any election, taking into account expected turnout.



9. Bensham Manor

- 9.1 At the Covid-effected elections in May 2021, the Government directed Returning Officers to seek alternative polling places to schools. In Bensham Manor alternatives were found to using Ecclesbourne Primary School (BMR5) and Bensham Manor Primary School (BMR6).
- 9.2 The alternative polling places for these districts, Queen's Community Centre (BMR5) and Haslemere Hall (BMR6) have been used at each election since 2021 in order to avoid the schools needing to close.
- 9.3 The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. However the location of them and the current division of polling districts means that in many cases voters are not able to go to their nearest polling station.



Proposed future arrangements

- 9.4 It is proposed that the polling places for the ward will remain unchanged, but there is some re-drawing of the polling district boundaries to make it more convenient for voters.
- 9.5 Access to the Queens Community Centre, the polling place for BMR5 is from Pawsons Road. It would be more convenient for voters in the top part of BMR5 (Lakehall Gardens, Lakehall Road, Norman Road, Penshurst Road and) to vote at Haslemere Hall. It is proposed that these streets are incorporated into BMR6.
- 9.6 For voters in the lower part of BMR6 (1a-44 and 1-37a Besham Manor Road, Kynaston Crescent, Marion Road, Palmerston Road, Pitt Road, Sandringham Road) it would be more convenient to vote at Queens Community Centre. It is proposed that these streets are incorporated into BMR5
- 9.7 Haslemere Hall, the polling place for BMR6 is actually located just in BMR3 polling district. This is confusing for the residents living next to Hazlemere

- Hall. It is proposed that Bensham Lane, Hazlemere Road, Penshurst Road and Torridge Road are incorporated into BMR6.
- 9.8 There would be some rebalancing of electorates needed. It is proposed that Bensham Close, Bensham Manor Road, Boswell Road, Brigstock Road and Seneca Road, currently in BMR4, and Bensham Manor Road, Ecclesbourne Road, Kynaston Road and Swain Road, currently in BMR6 polling district are incorporated into BMR3 polling district to vote at Age UK Croydon, Brigstock Road.
- 9.9 It is proposed that Winderbourne Road is moved from BMR1 to BMR2 polling district so that the polling place for BMR2 (Early Help Localities North, Winterbourne Road) is incorporated into the polling district, and for the convenience of electors in Winterbourne Road.



10. Broad Green

- 10.1 No change to the current arrangements are proposed. The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. The size of the electorates in the existing polling districts are below the Electoral Commission's recommended maximum number (2,250).
- 10.2 At the last polling district review (2020), the polling place for BGN1 was designated as the Scout Hut on Peppermint Close. It was taken out of use because it was in a state of disrepair, with the polling place being located at West Thornton Primary School the polling place for WTN6. No alternatives are evident in that part of the ward, so it is proposed that this arrangement continues.
- 10.3 At the last polling district review, Harris Primary Academy (formally Kingsley Primary School), Thomson Crescent was the designated polling place for BGN3. At the Covid-effected elections in May 2021, the Government directed Returning Officers to seek alternative polling places to schools, and it was relocated to Christ Church Centre, Sumner Road, polling place for BGN5. It is proposed that this arrangement continues in order to avoid the school needing to close.
- 10.4 Broad Green Library currently the polling station for BGN4 is closing. The Council are trying to find community groups to run the library building. It is intended that a clause will be included in the lease so that the building has to be made available as a polling place.
- 10.5 On this basis no changes to the current arrangements are proposed. An alternative to Broad Green Library is being sought if circumstances change and the library building is no longer available for use. If this necessitated a redrawing of polling district boundaries, a further limited review of arrangements in Broad Green ward could take place in 2025 in advance of the local elections in May 2026.



11. Coulsdon Town

- 11.1 The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. However current arrangements in Coulsdon Town are not ideal because of the lack of polling facilities in the lower part of the ward.
- 11.2 Electors in the area bounded by Brighton Road, Hollymeoak Road and Woodfield Hill in CTN5 are a considerable distance from their polling place at Chipstead Valley Primary School over half an hour walk, without pavements for parts of the route. Electors therefore have to drive if they wish to vote in person.
- 11.3 This area has been reviewed and there are no suitable venues for a polling place, or a location for a temporary polling station. Unfortunately there appears to be no alternative to the electors living in this area travelling to a polling station. While far from ideal, it should be noted that this small area is unlike most of the rest of the borough. It is physically separated from the rest of the ward by fields. The nearest shops are over 20 minutes' walk in Hooley. Residents are therefore used to driving to access amenities.
- 11.4 Similarly, electors in the southern-most part of CTN6 are a considerable distance from their polling station at Coulsdon Library. A small residential garage has been used in the past, however it is not considered suitable because of the space needed. This part of the borough is bounded by Farthing Down and Brighton Main Line. There are no suitable venues for a polling station in that part of the ward or a location for a temporary polling place. The nearest polling place in the borough is Poppy Café, Coulsdon Memorial Ground (Old Coulsdon OCN2). However the building is too small to accommodate a second polling station. Coulsdon Library appears to be the closest option.
- 11.5 There is currently no venue suitable as a polling place on the Cane Hill Estate. The Cane Hill Hospital Chapel could be a potential polling place in the future, but it is not currently open and available
- 11.6 It is therefore proposed that there are no changes to the current polling districts and polling places, however, a future limited review of polling arrangements in Coulsdon Town could take place if potential polling places are identified that will improve the arrangements for voters in the southern parts of the ward.




12. Crystal Palace and Upper Norwood

Current arrangements:


12.1 The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. However, there is an imbalance in the electorate sizes and in particular the electorate in CPU4 is above the Electoral Commission's recommended number of voters. Therefore some re-drawing of polling district boundaries are proposed to address this.

Proposed future arrangements:

- 12.2 Because of the geography of the ward and the location of available polling places, it is difficult to rebalance the electorate entirely, but some small redrawing of the polling district boundaries would allow for all of them to have polling station electorates of less than 2,250.
- 12.3 CPU1 and CPU5 currently have low electorates, however incorporating parts of either CPU2 or CPU4 into them would be more inconvenient for electors who are moved. Therefore no changes to CPU1 or CPU5 are proposed.
- 12.4 In order to reduce the electorate in CPU4, it is proposed that Harold Road and Ravensdale Gardens are moved to CPU2, and High View Close, Cypress Hill and Sunset Gardens are moved to CPU6.
- 12.5 This would further increase the electorate in CPU6. Therefore it is proposed that Braybrook Gardens, Fox Hill, Fox Hill Gardens, Hetley Gardens, Jenson Way, Lansdown Place and Reynard Drive are moved from CPU6 to CPU3.



13. Fairfield

- 13.1 The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. However since the creation of the new wards in 2018, there has been a huge amount of development in Fairfield ward. This has resulted in extremely imbalanced electorates between the existing polling districts.
- 13.2 The most significant issue is the large electorate in FFD2 polling district. Since 2022 this has been addressed by splitting the polling station register between two issuing desks to increase capacity at Bedford Hall. However, the polling station electorate is already 3,288. There are another 250 residential units due to be built in this district, and there are currently already over 800 properties in the district with no electors. So there is potential for the electorate in the polling district to significantly increase further.
- 13.3 FFD3 polling district has a current polling station electorate of 1,195. Although it is below the Electoral Commission's recommended number of electors, there are already 1,375 properties with no electors (over 700 in Enclave House alone) so the electorate here can also be expected to increase significantly.



Future proposals:

- 13.4 In order to address the imbalance in electorate, and also to take into account further future residential development it is proposed that a new polling district is created.
- 13.5 It is proposed that that the current FFD2 polling district is split into three. The top part of the district, including Chartwell Close, Lambert Place, Saffron Central Square, St James's Road, Tavistock Road, Wellesley Road (north of Bedford Park) would continue to vote at the current Bedford Hall polling place. This would continue to be described as FFD2. In addition Wellesley Road (49-6 Wellesley Parade) are moved from the current FFD6 district into FFD2.
- 13.6 It is proposed that the central part of the current FFD2 district including Bedford Park, Bedford Place, Dingwall Road (north of Lansdowne Road) Lansdowne Road, Sydenham Road and Wellesley Road (between Bedford

- Park and Landsdown Road are combined with the existing FFD6 polling district, polling place at St Michael's Parish Church Hall, Poplar Walk. This will be FFD3 polling district.
- 13.7 It is proposed that the lower part of FFD2 polling district including Caithness Walk, Dingwall Road (south of Lansdowne Road) and Wellesley Road (south of Lansdowne Road are joined with part of current FFD3 district north of Barclay Road. This new polling district would vote in a new polling place located in the room at the rear of The Cube, at the side of Fairfield Halls. This will be FFD4 polling district.
- 13.8 It is proposed that the remainder of the current FFD3 polling district, south of Barclay Road, with the addition of Edridge Road from FFD4 district. This will be FFD7 polling district, polling place at Croydon Spiritual Church, Chatsworth Road.
- 13.9 It is proposed that the remainder of FFD4 district will become FFD6 polling district, polling place at the Parish Church of St Andrew Croydon, Southbridge Road.
- 13.10 It is proposed that part of Church Road, Church Street, George Street, Howley Road, Old Palace Road and Roman Way (north of Howley Road) is moved from FFD5 polling district into FFD1 polling district.
- 13.11 No changes to the polling places for FFD1 (Tamworth Halls, Tamworth Road) and FFD5 (Croydon Central Library) are proposed.



14. Kenley

- 14.1 No change to the current arrangements are proposed.
- 14.2 The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. The size of the electorates in the existing polling districts are below the Electoral Commission's recommended maximum number (2,250).
- 14.3 It is acknowledged that there is a significant reliance on the use of schools as polling places in this ward, but there is a lack of alternatives in the Ward. All Saints Church was investigated as a potential polling place but its location on a hill, the lack of pavement near to the location, and difficult access to the site meant that it was assessed to be unsuitable as a polling place.



15. New Addington North

- 15.1 When the current polling districts came into effect in 2018 and there was no viable location for a permanent polling place in NAN3. Therefore a temporary polling station was located in Dunsfold Way. However, it is felt that temporary units are no longer suitable for a number of reasons.
 - They are expensive, costing in the region of £5,000, 10 times the average hire charge for a polling station
 - Facilities for staff are poor, for example they must use a portaloo
 - It is too small for a presiding officer and 3 poll clerks that have been used since the introduction of Voter ID
 - There is no space for private Voter ID checks
 - There is no space for any additional seating should an elector need it
 - Any queues would be outside
 - They do not have suitable disabled access additional adaptations need to be made
 - There is a risk of vandalism when sited prior to polling day
 - There is a risk that the site is not clear of cars, when sited
- 15.2 For a number of elections, the polling station for NAN3 has been located alongside the polling station for NAN4 polling district (Goldcrest Community Centre in 2021, 2022 and GLA election 2024 and Tudor Academy General Election 2024).
- 15.3 The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. No changes to the polling places in the ward are proposed.



Proposed future arrangements:

- 15.4 Because two polling districts NAN3 and NAN4 are currently voting in the same polling place, the potential for combining the two districts was investigated, however this would have resulted in the combined polling district having an electorate above the Electoral Commission's recommended maximum number.
- 15.5 The number of districts and polling places can be reduced to three without electors effected by the changes having any further distance to travel to vote, and without the electorates at any of the polling places being above the Electoral Commission's recommended number by re-drawing the boundaries of the polling districts.
- 15.6 It is proposed that that the current NAN3 polling district is split. The top part the district, including Alwyn Close, Dunsfold Way, Headley Drive, Ivers Way, Leigh Crescent and Lodge Lane (above Castle Hill Avenue) are moved into NAN2 polling district and 89-139 Headley Drive are moved from NAN4 to NAN2. This district would vote at Castle Hill Church, Dunley Drive.

- 15.7 It is proposed that the rest of the current NAN3 polling district, including Betchworth Way, Castle Hill Avenue, Horsley Drive, King Henry's Drive, Lodge Lane (below Castle Hill Avenue), Tifford Avenue, Unity Close, Walton Green and Westcott Close is combined with the current NAN4 polling district. The polling place is Goldcrest Community Centre, and the polling district is be renamed NAN3.
- 15.8 In order to rebalance the electorates, it is proposed that The Lindens is moved from NAN2 to NAN1.



17. Norbury and Pollards Hill


- 17.1 At the last full review of polling districts and polling places, the current NPH2 polling district was split in two. The polling places were located at The Royal British Legion, London Road, and The Lawn Tennis Club, Ederline Avenue.
- 17.2 In 2019 access to the tennis club site was deemed unsuitable (there is no lighting and it is very uneven). As a result the two polling districts were merged to become the current NPH2 district, and The Royal British Legion was designated as the polling place.
- 17.3 The Royal British Legion then closed, and since 2021, Norbury Library has been used as the polling place. This is not ideal as it is in a different polling district, causing confusion to electors. The number of polling station electors is also significantly above the Electoral Commission's maximum recommended number.
- 17.4 The current polling places have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff, but changes to NPH2 district need to be made.

- 17.5 It is proposed that NPH2 is divided in the same way as in 2018, with Craignish Avenue, London Road (1168-1466), Norbury Cresent (1-125 and 2-100), St Helens Crescent, and St Helens Road, forming one district, with its polling place located at Liberty Christian Ministries, 1a Norbury Crescent. This will be polling district NPH5.
- 17.6 It is proposed that the second polling district is made up of Ardfern Avenue, Dalmeny Avenue, Dubbar Avenue, Ederline Avenue, Kilmartin Avenue, Kintyre Close, London Road (1102 1170), Melrose Avenue, Norbury Cresent (127-273 and 102-288) and Strathyre Avenue, with its polling place located at The Scout Hut, Endeavour Halls, 273 Norbury Crescent. This will be polling district NPH4.
- 17.7 Both new polling places have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff.
- 17.8 It is proposed that the polling station for NPH3 polling district is changed to Norbury Library, Beatrice Avenue rather than Norbury Methodist Church as it is a council owned building, and will be available as required and at a lower cost.
- 17.9 It is proposed that the current NPH4 polling district is re-named NPH2.



- 18.1 The current polling places have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff.
- 18.2 At the last polling district review, Kensington Avenue Primary School was the designated polling place for NPK4. At the Covid-effected elections in May 2021, the Government directed Returning Officers to seek alternative polling places to schools, and it was relocated to St Oswald's Church Hall, polling place for NPK2. - 18.3 Because the two polling districts, NPK2 and NPK4 are currently voting at the same polling place, the potential for combining the two districts was investigated, but this would have resulted in the combined polling district having an electorate above the Electoral Commission's recommended maximum number.
- 18.4 However by re-drawing the boundaries of the current NPK2, NPK3 and NPK4 polling districts, it is possible to condense the current three districts into two, with electors effected by the changes having little or no extra distance to travel to vote and without the electorates at any of the polling places being above the Electoral Commission's recommended number.
- 18.5 It is proposed that the current NPK4 polling district is split with the top part, including Buckingham Avenue, Buckingham Gardens, Golf Close, Green Lane (57-149 above Westminster Avenue), Kensington Avenue, Norbury Avenue (199-243 and 202-230 above Highbury Avenue) and Willowtree Way, being incorporated into NPK2, voting at St Oswald's Church Hall.
- 18.6 The lower part of the current NPK4 polling district including County Road, Green Lane (1-55 below Westminster Avenue), Hawthorn Avenue, Highbury Avenue, Norbury Avenue (128-200 and 121-197 below Highbury Avenue) and

- Westminster Avenue being incorporated into NPK3 voting at the Croydon African Caribbean Family Organisation.
- 18.7 To help re-balance the electorates it is proposed that Florida Road is moved from NPK3 polling district to NPK2 polling district.
- 18.8 It is proposed NPK5 polling district is re-named NPK4.





- 19.2 It is noted that additional temporary lighting on the route from the street to the Poppy Café, Coulsdon Memorial Ground, polling place for OCN2 should be installed.

- 19.4 It is proposed that Fox Lane and Old Fox Close are moved from OCN3 to OCN5 as the polling place at Oasis Academy Coulsdon is closer than their current polling place at Tollers Community Centre, Goodenough Way.
- 19.5 While OCN2 polling district does have a small electorate, this district is at the bottom of the a steep long hill, so incorporating it into one of the other districts is not viewed as realistic so no change to this district is proposed.
- 19.6 Bradmore Green Library, currently the polling place for OCN1 is closing. The Council are trying to find community groups to run the library building. It is intended that a clause will be included in the lease so that the building has to be made available as a polling place.
- 19.7 On this basis no changes to the current arrangements for OCN1 are proposed. An alternative to Bradmore Green Library is being sought if circumstances change and the library building is no longer available for use. If this necessitated a re-drawing of polling district boundaries, a further limited review of arrangements in Old Couldson ward could take place later in 2025 in advance of the local elections in May 2026.




- 21.1 While the current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. There are a number of issues that need to be addressed in this ward.
- 21.2 The polling place for PWC5 polling district, St Barbabus Church Scout Hut, will not be available in the future as it is being sold for development.
- 21.3 The polling place for PWC4 polling district, St James's Church, is located on hill, with no car park. It is not ideal for electors with mobility issues.
- 21.4 There are around 350 new homes being built in the PWC2 polling district this is very likely to increase the electorate in this polling district to a level above the Electoral Commission's recommended number of voters. - 21.5 It is proposed that a new PWC7 polling district is created from the existing parts of PWC1 and PWC2 polling districts. Both the new PWC7 polling district and the remainder of PWC1 polling district will vote as a double polling station at the same polling place, St Marks Church Hall. There will be no noticeable change to those voters in the current PWC1 district. Many of those electors being moved from PWC2 will arguably find the new arrangement more convenient. The smaller PWC2 polling district will then have the capacity to manage the increased electorate as a result of the planned future development in the area.
- 21.6 It is proposed that Church Hill, Church Road, Deacon Close 21a-95 and 34a-122 Foxley Lane, Peaks Hill, Peaks Hill Rise, Plough Lane, The Bridle Road and Woodcote Drive are moved from PWC1 to PWC7
- 21.7 It is proposed that Atalanta Close, Ensign Close, High Tree Close, Highbarrow Close, Highfield Road, Hillthorpe Close, Holmoak Close, Oscar Close, Pringle Gardens and Russell Hill are moved from PCW2 to PWC7
- 21.8 No change to PWC3 polling district or polling place is proposed.
- 21.9 While it is acknowledged that the location of the polling place for PWC4 at St James's Church is not ideal for electors with mobility issues, there are no

- other alternatives in the district. The polling place used prior to 2021, St John the Baptist Church Club Room, is no longer available. Possible alternatives in the Kenley ward (Harris Academy Kenley and Kenley Memorial Hall) are a significant distance for all electors to travel. Therefore no change to the current arrangements are proposed for PWC4.
- 21.10 The polling place for PWC5, St Barnabus Church Scout Hut is being sold. It is not expected to be available in 2026. There is no timetable for the redevelopment of the site. Beaumont Primary School which is in the current PWC6 polling district appears to be the only option as a polling place for electors in PWC5.
- 21.11 It is proposed that Beaumont Primary School is the polling place for PWC5 and that the part of PWC6 south east of the railway line (Hartley Down, Hartley Farm, Hartley Hill, Hartley Old Road, Hartley Way and Stoats Nest Road) are incorporated into PWC5.
- 21.12 No change to polling place, for the now reduced PWC6 polling district is proposed.





Future proposed arrangements:

- 22.3 POR2 polling district also has a high electorate, and moving electors from POR1 to POR2 will not solve the over allocation of electors in POR1, it will simply move the problem to another polling place, and will be more inconvenient for the electors effected.
- 22.4 The shape of the ward and the location of railway line which is a physical barrier through the ward means that moving any electors from either POR1 or POR2 to POR3 would also inconvenience the voters. Therefore no changes to POR3 or POR4 are proposed.
- 22.5 It is proposed that the current POR1 polling district is split, with the top half of the district above Edgehill Road forming a new polling district POR5. This would include Allder Way, Barnards Place, Blackford Close, Chancellor Gardens, Edgehill Road, Hamond Close, Harepit Close, High Street, Joshua Close, Kendra Hall Road, Knighton Close, Lambourne Close, Lynscott Way, Montpellier Road, Netherheys Drive, Pampisford Road, Riddlesdown Road, Whytecliffe Road North, Willowbank Place and Wyndhurst Close.

Christ Church Hall, the current polling station for POR1 does have sufficient space for a double polling station should Regina Coeli be unavailable.




24. Selhurst

- 24.1 Since the last polling district and places review, the polling place for SEL2 has been moved from Broadmead Junior School to The Crescent Primary School which was already the polling place for SEL1. This was to minimise the impact on schools in the area. The ward is geographically small so it was felt that this was not a significant inconvenience for electors.
- 24.2 Whitehorse Resource Centre was the polling place for SEL4, but was sold in 2024 and no longer available. West Croydon Baptist Church, was used as the polling place for SEL4 at both elections in 2024. However, this is actually located in SEL3 polling district. A significant number of voters in SEL3 currently have to walk past the church to their polling place at Bridge Place Community Centre to vote. It would be far more convenient for those electors in SEL3 who live to the west of the railway line, to vote at West Croydon Baptist Church.
- 24.3 The polling station electorate in SEL4 is higher than the Electoral Commissions recommended maximum number.
- 24.4 The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. No changes to the polling places are proposed. However some redrawing of polling district boundaries are needed in order to re-balance the allocation of electors to them.

- 24.5 It is proposed that Hogarth Crescent, 97-107 St James's Road, Strathmore Road, Tavistock Grove, and Whitehorse Road are moved from SEL3 to SEL4 polling district, polling place West Croydon Baptist Church.



25. Selsdon and Addington Village

- 25.1 No change to the current arrangements are proposed. The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. The size of the electorates in the existing polling districts are below the Electoral Commission's recommended maximum number (2,250).
- 25.2 In comparison with other wards with similar electorates, this ward has more polling stations other wards with similar sized electorates have between 3 and 5 polling stations.
- 25.3 Splitting SAV5 polling district has been considered, to incorporate half of the polling district into SAV6 and half into SAV4. However the distance that some electors from SAV5 would need to walk in order to go to the polling station, and the hill they would need to negotiate on the way back, would likely mean many would drive. The polling place SAV6 is a residential garage. Significant numbers of electors driving there from SAV5 would cause residents in the area inconvenience.
- 25.4 Both SAV1 and SAV2 polling districts have very small electorates. SAV1 only has 539 polling station electors and SAV2 632 polling station electors. Combining SAV1 and SAV2 polling districts, with the polling place located at Addington Methodist Church, has been considered. However, the walking route from SAV1 involves crossing the busy junction at the bottom of Gravel Lane, and tram lines. It would also leave some electors with a walk of over 25 minutes to their new polling place.





- 27.1 The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff.
- 27.2 At the last polling districts and polling places review, Oasis Academy Shirley was designated as the polling place for SHN1. At the Covid-effected elections in May 2021, the Government directed Returning Officers to seek alternative polling places to schools. - 27.4 It is proposed that Woodside Baptist Church Hall is the designated as the polling place for SHN1. Although outside the ward, for most electors it will only add a couple of minutes to their journey time to the polling station so there is minimal impact on electors, while removing the impact having a polling station there has on the school.
- 27.5 It is not possible to address the high polling station electorate in SHN3 by splitting the polling station register and having two issuing tables to increase capacity because the polling place, St George's Church Hall does not have the space for a second issuing desk.
- 27.6 It is proposed that the boundary between SHN2 and SHN3 is redrawn so that the top of SHN3 is incorporated into SHN2 polling district. This would include Brookside Way, Bywood Avenue, Chaffinch Avenue, Chaffinch Close, Fairford Avenue, Fairford Close, Meadow Avenue, Oak Way, Stoneleigh Park Avenue, The Glade (163-197 and 140-174), and The Rosery.
- 27.7 As well as reducing the electorate in SHN3 it would increase the electorate in SHN2 which is under-utilised as a polling place.









- 29.3 There is not an obvious way to reduce the electorate in SCN6 by moving electors into SCN5, without inconveniencing electors that are moved to SHN5. Having an additional issuing desk would increase capacity, but administratively it is better to create a new polling district.
- 29.4 It is proposed that a new SCN7 polling district is created by splitting SCN6, with Columbine Avenue, Elysian Place, Fenwick Place, Hailing Park Road, Nicola Close, Pampisford Road, St Ann's Way St Augustine's Avenue (42-84 and 25-67), Tirlemont Road and Vauxhall Gardens making up the new polling district.
- 29.5 It is proposed that the polling place for the new district is Regina Coeli Catholic Primary School. This would be a double polling station venue, shared with the new POR5 polling district.
- 29.6 If Regina Coeli were not available there is the capacity to have a double polling station for SHN6 and SHN7 at St Augustine's Church Centre.



- 31.5 In order to reduce the electorate in TNH6, it is proposed that Bedser Close, Coates Close, 2-34 and 1-26b and Ashleigh Court Norbury Avenue, Sandfield Gardens, Sandfield Road and Wychwood Avenue are moved into THN5.
- 31.6 It is proposed that Hunter Road, Kitchener Road, Natal Road and Roberts Close are moved from TNH4 to TNH2 polling district and Milner Road and Norbury Road are moved from TNH5 to THN2 polling district. These changes would help rebalance the electorates but also mean that the electors effected would have a shorter distance to go to the polling place located at Elim Pentecostal Church.
- 31.7 Spurgeon's College have been approached regarding using it as a polling place in the future. It is proposed that Spurgeon's College is designated as the polling station for TNH7, but that if it is unavailable that the Waterside Centre will be used.






- 32.1 The current polling places used have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. However there are a number of issues regarding the division of the ward and designation of polling places that need to be addressed.
- 32.2 WDN7 polling district is very small, just 268 polling station electors. The polling district was created when the new wards came into effect in 2018, because WDN1 and WDN7 were in a different parliamentary constituency than the rest of the ward. The electors in WDN7 are located on the east side of Wandle Park and it was considered too far for electors to walk to the WDN1 polling station (at Startup Croydon, Whitestone Way) during the hours of darkness when the park is closed. Now that the parliamentary boundaries have changed separating WDN1 and WDN7 from the rest of the ward is not required, and it is hard to justify having a separate polling place for such a small number of voters.
- 32.3 At the last polling district and polling places review, because there was no viable location for a permanent polling place in WDN3, a Temporary polling station located on Waddon Court Road was designated as the polling place for the district. However, it is felt that temporary units are no longer suitable for a number of reasons.
- They are expensive, costing in the region of £5,000, 10 times the average hire charge for a polling station
- Facilities for staff are poor, for example they must use a portaloo
- It is too small for a presiding officer and 3 poll clerks that have been used since the introduction of Voter ID
- There is no space for private Voter ID checks
- There is no space for additional seating should an elector need it
- Any queues of electors would be outside
- They do not have suitable disabled access additional adaptations need to be made
- There is a risk of vandalism when sited prior to polling day
- There is a risk that the site is not clear of cars, when sited
- Local residents are inconvenienced by not being able to use the car park it is located in
- 32.4 At the GLA elections in 2021 and the elections in 2024 the polling place for WDN3 was located in Waddon Leisure Centre.

Proposed future arrangements:

- 32.5 It is proposed that the polling places used in 2024 are used in the future, but that the polling district boundaries are re-drawn to ensure that there is a more even split of electorate. But in doing so, making sure that electors are not negatively impacted by the changes.
- 32.6 It is proposed that part of Polling district WDN2, including Bourne Street, Kemble Street, Lower Church Street, Rectory Grove, Ridge's Yard, Siddons Road, St Johns Road, Vicarage Road, and Waddon New Road are incorporated into WDN7 polling district. This better utilises the Salvation Army, maintaining the arrangements for those electors in the current WDN7 polling district and will be more convinient for many of the electors moved from WDN2.
- 32.7 In addition Benson Road is moved from WDN3 to WDN7 to help re-balance the electorates.
- 32.8 It is proposed to split polling district WDN3. Cherry Hall Gardens, Court Drive, Croydon Road, Jennett Road, Limes Avenue, Lodge Avenue, Lynwood Gardens, Mill Lane, Purley Way (552-414 and 273-331), Rigby Close, The Ridgeway, Waddon Close, Waddon Court Road, Waddon Road and Wandle Side, are incorporated into WDN1 polling district polling place at Startup Croydon.
- 32.9 For electors in the current WDN3 district who reside to the west of Purley Way, crossing Purley Way to go to Startup Croydon to vote would be easier than crossing of Purley Way at Five Ways Junction to vote at Waddon Leisure Centre.
- 32.10 It is proposed that Alton Road Courtney Road, Godson Road, 335-407A Purley Way and Waddon Park Avenue are incorporated into WDN4 polling place Waddon Leisure Centre.
- 32.11 In addition it is proposed Cornerstone Way is moved from WDN2 to WDN1 polling district.
- 32.12 It is also proposed that Barrow Road, Bates Avenue, Burgos Close, Chasemore Gardens, Hillier Gardens, Thornloe Gardens, Waddon Way and Williams Terrace are moved from WDN4 to WDN5, polling place Aerodrome Children's Centre.








- 34.1 At the last polling district and places review, Robert Fitzroy Academy was designated as the polling place for WDS6 polling district. However the school have been opposed to this, not only because of the disruption that this causes to the school, but the financial impact it has on them.
- In 2022 a mobile unit in the car park of Robert Fitzroy Academy was used. This enabled the school to remain open. However, mobile units are not viewed a good option (see paragraph 32.2 above). In addition, the Election Claims Unit will not fund a mobile unit at a school.
- 34.3 At the elections in 2024 Woodside Green Christian Centre was used as the polling place for WDS6 and is a good venue.
- The polling places used in 2024 have been assessed as suitable venues in terms of accessibility and facilities for electors and polling staff. The size of the electorates in the existing polling districts are below the Electoral Commission's recommended maximum number (2,250).

Proposed future arrangements:

- 34.5 It is proposed that the designation of Woodside Green Cristian Centre as the polling place for WDS6 is formalised. While it is acknowledged that some electors are further away from their polling place as a result of the change, the majority of electors are within 10 minutes' walk of Woodside Green Christian Centre.
- 34.6 In addition, it is proposed that Hermitage Lane, Malcolm Road and Sonning Road which are next to Woodside Green Christian Centre are moved into WDS6 district so that the polling station is within the district, and for the convenience of the electors nearby.
- 34.7 It is proposed that Davidson Road, Tennison Road and Sutton Gardens are moved from WDS3 to WDS4 so they vote at South Norwood Leisure centre. This would not only re-balance the electorate between the two districts but the new polling place would be slightly closer for electors effected.
