b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Incidents of a criminal nature will be reported to the Police. The Club has CCTV coverage, operated and maintained at the premises. The CCTV system conforms to the following points:- Cameras, are sited to observe the entrance and exit doors, are capable of visually confirming the nature of the crime committed, have the recording device located in a secure area, are regularly maintained, have signage displayed to advise CCTV is in operation, digital images are kept for 31 days.

c) Public safety

Appropriate fire safety procedures are in place, including fire extinguishers (foam, H2O and CO2), fire blanket, internally illuminated fire exit sighs, numerous smoke detectors and emergency lighting. All appliances are inspected annually. All emergency exits are kept free from obstruction at all times.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

All customers are asked to leave quietly. Clear and legible notices are prominently displayed to remind customers to leave quietly, and have regard to our neighbours

e) The protection of children from harm

The Steward and staff ask persons who appear to be under the age of 21 for photographic ID bearing their date of birth. Admission of individuals under the age of 16 is restricted to authorised occasions and with the proviso that they are accompanied by a responsible adult.
