PAWSONS ROAD, CROYDON & SANDRINGHAM ROAD,
THORNTON HEATH

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement works by SGN, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Pawsons Road, Croydon and Sandringham Road, Thornton Heath.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - a) Sandringham Road will be closed between its junction with Kynaston Road and the north-eastern flank wall of No. 2 Sandringham Road **from 05 May to 19 May 2025.**
 - b) Pawsons Road will be closed between its junctions with Lion Road and Mayo Road **from 09 June to 14 July 2025.**
3. During the closure, the alternative routes for traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Sandringham Road Southbound: Via Pitt Road, Pawsons Road, Palmerston Road
 - Sandringham Road Northbound: Via Pitt Road, Kynaston Avenue, Kynaston Road
 - Pawsons Road Southbound: Via Queens Road, Windmill Road, Whitehorse Road
 - Pawsons Road Northbound: Via Queens Road, Bensham Lane, Brigstock Road, High Street, Whitehorse Road
4. The Order will come into operation on 05 May 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out as detailed above. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
