POLLARDS HILL NORTH, NORBURY

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PARKING & PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate new water connection works on behalf of Thames Water, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit pedestrian traffic movements and parking in Pollards Hill North, Norbury.
2. During the work:
  - a) Parking will be suspended and temporary waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time on both sides of the road outside Nos. 74 to 86 Pollards Hill North.
  - b) The footway outside Nos. 80 to 84 Pollards Hill North will be closed and pedestrians will be diverted to a walkway in the carriageway.
3. The Order will come into operation on 08 May 2025, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed within 10 days. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) any vehicle involved in conducting the said work.
  - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
