PN46 - CROYDON COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 CHATSWORTH ROAD, CROYDON TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

- 1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate new gas connection works by SGN, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in Chatsworth Road, Croydon.
- 2. Whilst the said works are taking place Chatsworth Road will be closed between its junction with Coombe Road and the northern boundary of No. 55 Coombe Road.
- 3. Whilst the closure is in force, the alternative routes for traffic will be as detailed below.
- Via Coombe Road, Park Lane, Mulgrave Road and vice versa.
- Via Coombe Road, Park Hill Road, Barclay Road and Chatsworth Road.
- 4. The Order will come into operation on 27 May 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 01 June 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.
- 5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
