ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14
AS AMENDED AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
NORMAN AVENUE, PURLEY BURY AVENUE, PURLEY DOWNS ROAD, PENWORTHAM ROAD,
VICTORIA AVENUE, & YEW TREE WALK, SOUTH CROYDON & PURLEY
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement work by SGN, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic in the above roads.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place the roads/sections of road will be closed as detailed below

3. Whilst the closures are in place the diversion routes for traffic will be as detailed below.
 - Norman Avenue Westbound: Via Purley Downs Road, Riddlesdown Road, Brighton Road, Sanderstead Road, and Florence Road.
 - Norman Avenue Eastbound: Via Purley Downs Road, Penwortham Road, and Purley Oaks Road.
 - Victoria Avenue Southbound: Via Penwortham Road, and Purley Downs Road.
 - Victoria Avenue Northbound: Via Penwortham Road, Purley Oaks Road, and Norman Avenue.
 - Yew Tree Walk: Via Brancaster Lane, and Purley Bury Avenue.
 - Purley Downs Road: Via Brighton Road, Purley Road, Godstone Road, Downs Court Road, Mitchley Avenue, Rectory Park, Sanderstead Hill and vice versa.
 - Purley Bury Avenue: Via Brancaster Lane, and Yew Tree Walk.
 - Penwortham Road: Via Victoria Avenue, and Norman Avenue.
4. The Order will come into operation on 02 June 2025, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed as detailed above. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
5. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
