TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER

SOUTH NORWOOD FESTIVAL, SOUTH NORWOOD  
ASSOCIATED RESTRICTIONS

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the South Norwood Festival they intend to make a Traffic Order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict traffic and parking in Lawrence Road and Cargreen Road.
2. During the festival the effect of the Order will be to:
  - Close Cargreen Road between the entrance to South Norwood Recreation Ground and its junction with Lawrence Road.
  - Suspend parking and introduce waiting and loading restrictions operating “at any time” on the north-east (odd-numbered) side of Lawrence Road.
  - Suspend parking and introduce waiting and loading restrictions operating “at any time” on both sides of Cargreen Road between the Recreation Ground entrance and its junction with Lawrence Road.
3. The provisions of the Order will not prevent access being maintained for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which this Order relates, or to any other premises accessible from, and only from such a road.
4. The Order will come into effect on 06 July 2025 and will remain in force for one day.
5. Nothing in the Order shall apply:
  - a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or Civil Enforcement Officer.
  - b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
