ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED  
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991  
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

HAVELOCK ROAD, CROYDON  
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate works to install water pressure monitoring equipment, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit traffic movements and parking in Havelock Road, Croydon.
2. During the work:
  - a) Havelock Road will be closed at its junction with Addiscombe Road.
  - b) The two parking bays on the east side of Havelock Road adjacent to the flank wall of No. 203 Addiscombe Road will be suspended.
  - c) The two parking bays nearest the junction with Addiscombe Road on the west side of Havelock Road, adjacent to Cecil Court, will be suspended.
3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative route for traffic will be via Addiscombe Road, Outram Road, Lower Addiscombe Road, Elgin Road and reversed.
4. The Order will come into operation on 07 July 2025, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 09 July 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such an extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) any vehicle involved in conducting the said work.
  - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
  - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
