DUPPAS ROAD, CROYDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate underground cable repairs on behalf of UKPN, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit traffic movements in Duppas Road, Croydon.
2. During the work Duppas Road will be closed at its junction with Epsom Road.
3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative routes for diverted vehicles will be as detailed below.
 - Via Duppas Road, Duppas Hill Road, Old Town A236, Rectory Grove, Waddon New Road, Epsom New Road and Duppas Road.
 - Via Duppas Road, Stafford Road, Denning Avenue and Bramley Hill.
 - Via Epsom Road, Stafford Road, Denning Avenue and Bramley Hill.
4. The Order will come into operation on 10 July 2025 and will remain in force for a maximum duration of 18 months, to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibition will only apply during such times and to such an extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle or person involved in conducting the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
