Proposed Amended Zebra Crossing

The zig-zag markings of the existing crossing outside Monks Orchard Primary School, The Glade, are proposed to be lengthened by 12.5 metres on the south-west (odd-numbered) side of the road, to mirror the zig-zag markings on the north-east (even-numbered) side. This would extend the markings across the frontages of Nos. 253 and 255 The Glade.
