The Croydon (Traffic Movement) (No.2) Order 2025

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on 11 August 2025 made the above Traffic Order under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be:
 - a) To make Lansdowne Road one-way eastbound between its junctions with Wellesley Road and Walpole Road.
 - b) To update the map-based tiles to the Schedules attached to the above Order to accurately represent the new arrangements as they exist on site.
- 3. Copies of the Order, which will come into operation on 14 August 2025, and of all associated Orders can be inspected between 9am and 4pm, Monday to Friday inclusive, until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Order is made, by appointment with the Parking Design Team, 3rd Floor, Zone C, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA (telephone 020 8726 6000 and ask for Parking Design). Alternatively all related documents or further informationcan be requested by email to Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk.
- 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order is made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
