- Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they intend to make a
 Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to close
 the section of Westfield Avenue, South Croydon, specified in this notice, to
 vehicular traffic at the times and on the date specified in the Schedule to
 this notice, to facilitate a play street.
- During the date and times specified in the Schedule to this notice Westfield Avenue will be closed between its junctions with Court Hill and Rectory Park.
- 3. During the closure the alternative route for traffic will be via Westfield Avenue, Court Hill, Brian Avenue, Shaw Crescent, Glebe Hyrst and Rectory Park and reversed, or via Rectory Park, Hyde Road, Copthorne Rise and Westfield Avenue.
- 4. The provisions of the Order will not prevent access being maintained for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which this Order relates, or to any other premises accessible from, and only from, such a road.
- 5. Nothing in the Order shall apply:
 - a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
 - b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
- 6. The Order will come into effect on Sunday 28 September 2025, during the times shown in the Schedule to this notice.
