ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED  
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991  
AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS

BINGHAM ROAD & CLAREMONT ROAD, CROYDON

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC & PARKING

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate kerb and footway works and the installation of a raised zebra crossing, they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict traffic movements and parking in Bingham Road and Claremont Road, Croydon.
2. Whilst the works are taking place:
  - a) Bingham Road will be closed between its junctions with Ashling Road and Baring Road.
  - b) Claremont Road will be closed at its junction with Bingham Road.
  - c) Parking within the closure area will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time.
  - d) The footways in Bingham Road, between its junctions with Ashling Road and Baring Road, will be closed as necessary during the works.
3. The Order will come into operation on 15 November 2025, and it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 23 November 2025. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required.
4. Whilst the closure is in place the alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Lower Addiscombe Road, Shirley Road and reversed. Pedestrians affected by the footway closures will be directed to the opposite footway.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
  - (b) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
  - (c) any vehicle involved in carrying out the specified works.
