**Scope of works comprises: Alterations to / removal of walls and hedging; Alterations to paths; Planting of various new trees; New forecourt landscaping (with seating and planting); External lighting improvements to building (and limited changes to site-wide lighting); heritage trail signage/sculptural elements.**
