DENNETT ROAD, CROYDON

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR & EQUESTRIAN TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate water valve repair works, they intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicular and equestrian traffic movements in Dennett Road, Croydon.
2. During the work Dennett Road will be closed between its junction with Mitcham Road and the north-eastern boundary of No. 200 Mitcham Road.
3. Whilst the closure remains in force the alternative routes for diverted traffic will be as detailed below.
 - North – Via Sutherland Road, Pemdevon Road, and London Road.
 - South – Via Sumner Road and Handcroft Road.
4. The Order will come into operation on 18 February 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 21 February 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibition will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The restriction shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) any vehicle involved in conducting the said work.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
