**PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF WAITING RESTRICTIONS & PARKING BAYS
HAYES LANE, KENLEY**

The Croydon (Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Loading and Waiting) and
(Free Parking Places) (No. F58) Order 20-

The Croydon (On-Street Charged-For Parking Places) (No. F59) Order 20-

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council proposes to make the above Traffic Orders under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Orders would be to make the following changes to existing parking arrangements to accommodate a new zebra crossing and zig-zag markings in Hayes Lane:**
 - a) **Remove the existing double yellow lines on the northwest side of Hayes Lane (outside Yateley Court), between the vehicular entrance of Yateley Court and a point 39.6 metres northeast of that entrance.**
 - b) **Remove the existing double yellow lines, single yellow line and four existing short-term parking bays, on the southeast side of Hayes Lane (outside Station Approach), between a point opposite the vehicular entrance of Yateley Court and a point 39.6 metres northeast of that entrance.**
 - c) **Relocate the existing disabled bay on the southeast side of Hayes Lane (outside Station Approach) to a point 21.23 metres northeast of its current location. This will replace one existing short-term parking bay. Note: two of the existing six short-term parking bays will be retained in their current location.**
3. A copy of the proposed Orders and all related documents can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Order was made or, as the case maybe, the Council decides not to make the Order, between 10am and 6pm, at Croydon Central Library, Katharine Street, CR9 1ET. Alternatively, all documents can be obtained by email request to Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk.
4. Persons desiring to object to the proposed Orders should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Parking Design Team, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon, CR0 1EA or email Parking Design (email address above) quoting the reference PD/CH/F58 & F59 by 04 February 2026.
5. The Order is intended to amend existing waiting restrictions, and remove/relocate parking bays on Hayes Lane, Kenley, to accommodate a new zebra crossing. The changes are part of a scheme to introduce improvements to create a safer environment for pedestrians.
