ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14, AS AMENDED
THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PARKING
VARIOUS LOCATIONS

1. Croydon Council, **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate works to install electric vehicle parking bays and charging points they have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict parking in the roads listed in the Schedule to this Notice.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place parking will be suspended and waiting and loading restrictions will apply at any time in the sections of road listed in column 2 of the Schedule to this Notice.
3. The Order will come into operation on the 19 January 2026, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on 06 February 2026. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further work be required. The prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. These restrictions shall not apply in respect of:
 - (a) A vehicle involved in carrying out the said works.
 - (b) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which the order applies.
 - (c) Anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.

SCHEDULE

1. Street Name	2. Location of parking suspension/waiting restrictions
Ashburton Avenue, Croydon	The north-west side, from the south-western end of the existing double yellow lines at the junction with Shirley Road south-westwards for 12 metres.
Elgin Road, Croydon	The east side, from the northern end of the existing single yellow line at the junction with Addiscombe Road northwards for 12 metres.
Goston Gardens, Thornton Heath	The south-west side, from a point opposite the north-western (front) wall of No. 1 Goston Gardens south-eastwards for 12 metres.
Reedham Park Avenue, Purley	The north-west side, from a point 7.79 metres north-east of the south-western (rear) boundary of No. 18 Whitefield Avenue, north-eastwards for 12 metres.
Sherwood Road, Croydon	The north-east side, from a point 2.9 metres south-east of the north-western (front) wall of No. 310 Lower Addiscombe Road, south-eastwards for 12 metres.
Stroud Green Way, Croydon	On the north-west side, from the south-western end of the existing disabled bay adjacent to the flank wall of Ashburton Memorial Homes, Stroud Green Way, south-westwards for 12 metres.
Wydehurst Road, Croydon	The south-west side, from a point 5.5 metres north-west of the north-western end of the existing double yellow lines at the junction with Sissinghurst Road, north-westwards for 12 metres.
