PROPOSED EXEMPTION FOR CYCLISTS TO EXISTING NO ENTRY/ONE-WAY
WORKING – VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN ADDISCOMBE WEST

The Croydon (Prescribed Routes) (No. F42a) Traffic Order 20-

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council proposes to make a Traffic Order under Section 6 and 124 of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Order would be to introduce an exemption for pedal cycles to existing no entry/one-way working arrangements on the roads/lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.**
3. A copy of the proposed Order and all related documents can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Order was made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Order, between 10am and 6pm, at Croydon Central Library, Katharine Street, CR9 1ET. Alternatively, all documents can be obtained by email request to Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk.

5. Persons desiring to object or make representations in relation to the proposed Orders should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Parking Design Team, Croydon Council, Floor 3, Zone C, Bernard Weatherill House, 8 Mint Walk, Croydon CR0 1EA or email Parking.Design@croydon.gov.uk quoting the reference PD/CH/F42a within 21 days of the publication of this notice (by 11 February 2026).
6. The Order is intended to exempt pedal cycles from existing no entry/one-way working arrangements within various roads in both Addiscombe West as shown in the Schedule to this notice. These proposals are aimed at improving accessibility, convenience, and the safety of cyclists.

Road Name	Location of no entry	Direction of one-way
Addiscombe Court Road	At its northernmost junction with Tunstall Road	North-westbound between its junctions with Tunstall Road
Brickwood Road	At its junction with Cedar Road	North-bound (entire length of road)
Hastings Road	At its junction with Warren Road	North-eastbound (entire length of road)
Morland Avenue	At the northern boundary of No. 36 Morland Avenue.	Northbound between its junction with Lower Addiscombe Road and the northern boundary of No. 36 Morland Avenue.
Tunstall Road	At its southernmost junction with Addiscombe Court Road	South-eastbound (entire length of road)
Warren Road	At its junction with Lower Addiscombe Road	South-westbound (entire length of road)
